AKC Agility Trials February 20 & 21, 2010



Thank you for entering the Stone City Kennel Club, Inc. Agility Trial!

Please check the final entry confirmation for your dog(s). If you find any errors, please notify the trial secretary via email at agilityentry@hughes.net (preferred) or by phone at (815) 469-5525. When using email, please be sure to type the email address carefully. If you do not get a response from me, I did not get your email, so please follow up with a phone call.

Pre-trial move ups must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 pm on Monday, February 15, 2010. Email move-ups are also acceptable. Verbal requests will not be accepted. Day to day move-ups must be made by the close of Saturday's trial for the Sunday trial. Move up forms will be available at the trial. Close of the trial will be considered when the ribbons have been awarded for the last class of the day.

Dogs in the "B" class will run first, followed by dogs in the "A" class for each jump height. Dogs in the Preferred program will run after dogs in the Regular program in their corresponding jump height. Running orders are preliminary, and subject to change due to withdrawals and move-ups received.

Per AKC's latest statement: Trial secretaries should continue to separate armbands of those who need measuring from self-service check-in so that the armband is not distributed until such time that the dog either gets a measurement or the exhibitor advises that a valid jump height card exists. The exhibitor does not have to show the card; they simply have to ask for their armband stating that they currently have a valid measurement.

If an entry form comes in with no jump height card notification attached (e.g. none of the boxes are checked or a form without the boxes is used), please place the dog on the club's Dogs To Be Measured List report until such time that the exhibitor states otherwise. In this manner, the responsibility is upon the exhibitor to communicate that a card exists or they must get their dog measured.

Please check your confirmation to see if your dog is correctly listed for height card. I do not have to see the card; just email me to change status or notify that a measurement is needed. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. **Please notify the Trial Secretary that your dog needs to be measured** unless you already check-marked on the entry form "My Dog Needs To Be Measured".

Food will be available on the grounds for purchase. Crating space in the building will be limited. The building will be open for set-up after 7:00 AM on Saturday, January 23rd, 2010.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Handlers who do not clean up after their dogs will be dismissed from the trial with no monies refunded.

Directions to Rush'N'Around Agility Center:

From north or southbound I-294: exit at I-80 west to I-57 south. Stay on I-57 south for 9.5 miles to the Manhattan-Monee Rd. exit and go west. Stay on Manhattan-Monee Rd. westbound for 6.5 miles and turn south (left) at Rt. 45 (stop sign with flashing light). Trial Site is 2.5 miles south on the west side of Rt. 45. Look for agility trial signs.

The easiest route for those taking the I-355 extension is I-355 south to I-80 east. Exit Route 45 south (about 9 miles) to trial site.

Workers

We wish to thank all of our exhibitors who have volunteered to work at the trial. If you have signed up to work, a worker schedule will be posted. Please double check the posted schedules when you arrive at the trial for your assignments; check in with the worker coordinator (Annette Narel) before the start of the class you are assigned to work in.
